
We're very lucky here at Fernhill. We have large playing fields, a purpose built trim trail, and a spacious enclosed Early Years and Key Stage 1 outdoor classroom. Our separate playground and adventure playground provide lots of room to run, learn, enjoy and play sports. We're looking forward to the re-opening of our swimming pool in the near future too.

Inside, our classrooms are bright and spacious. Windows on both sides mean we all have lots of natural light which we know helps our learning! We love our brightly coloured and well stocked library. Did you know we even have a special room that you enter through a key hole?

Curriculum

Our curriculum is built on developing our skills as lifelong learners. Resilience, resourcefulness, reflectiveness and collaboration underpin our learning and help us make very good progress. We know learning shouldn't be easy and use the learning pit to help us identify challenge. We work hard on building our language skills. Carefully chosen books are used as a basis for our English learning and linked to our topics where possible.

Phonics is taught discreetly in Year R and Key Stage 1 using Read, Write, Inc and we focus on developing fluency and reasoning in maths skills using Maths Mastery in all classes. Access to laptops and tablets enhance our learning. The SCARF programme is used throughout the school to teach PSHE.



Trips

We love a trip and know these help our learning so all year groups do their best to get out and about! Trips vary from year to year but just some of the places we have been to recently are: The Science Museum in Winchester, Wisley Gardens, Butser Farm, The Look Out Centre, the British Museum and our school council even visited the Houses of Parliament! At Christmas, we love our whole school trip to the pantomime! Year 5 and 6 have had the chance to develop independence skills during residential visits to Runways End and, of course, we visit our local Kite academies too.
